

# County Cup Rules

Amended 2020

## Eligibility

Regular team - any member in good standing with HCC, 18 years or older.

Senior team - any member in good standing with HCC, 55 years or older.

## Qualifying

Each team will consist of 12 players and 2 alternates.

Team members will be established by the following:

- A. Low gross winners in the Memorial Tournament will automatically qualify. Ties will playoff.
- B. The Top 4 in the Club Championship and ties, excluding A, automatically qualify.
- C. To fill the rest of the team through 10 players plus ties, the best three qualifying scores from The Memorial, The Club Championship and two one day qualifiers(set at tournament chairman's discretion), will be used.
- D. Remaining spots, if any, will be determined at the discretion of the Team Captain.
- E. In the event ties go past 12 players, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately after the last qualifier to determine those spots.

The tournament chairman will determine, at the time of each tournament, which tees the regular team and senior team must play in order for his score to be eligible.

Captains of each team are determined by the Club Championship.

Qualifiers from The Memorial and Club Championship must declare, at that time, which team they are on (regular/senior). If anyone qualifies in the Memorial or the Club Championship, but declines to play, the next best score qualifies. For example, someone wins the Memorial but is unable to play; the next best low gross score would qualify.

Once the team is set, if someone is unable to play, the first alternate would get that spot. The 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate would move up to the 1<sup>st</sup> alternate.
