Senior Club Championship and Senior County Cup Qualifying

The following are changes that will be in effect for 2025:

- The Senior Club Championship and Senior County Cup will be played from the **Gold Tees.**
- All Members 55 and older are eligible to compete for the Senior Club Championship and Senior County Cup.
- Any Member that chooses to compete for the overall Club Championship will play the Blue Tees.
- Senior County Cup Qualifying will consist of rounds completed in 2025 scheduled qualifier dates.
- Senior County Cup will automatically qualify the 4 lowest scores from the Senior Club
 Championship with the Senior Club Champion being named the 2025 Senior County Cup
 Captain.
- The lowest Senior gross score from the Memorial will receive an automatic spot on the Senior County Cup Team. If that individual decides not to compete, the next lowest score will receive the automatic qualifier spot.
- The major change for 2025 qualifying will be the using scores from the Tuesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday \$20 game as Senior County Cup Qualifying rounds. If the player is 55 to 64 they are eligible to play the gold tees, but will have their handicap adjusted for \$20 game team selection. The game must have a least 4 members playing that day. All qualifier rounds will be played as moving the ball in fairway only. Bunker played as lies (no rake and place). All putts must be holed. Double bogey max on any hole. The individual is responsible for FILLING OUT A <u>SEPERATE</u> QAULIFYING SORECARD. The Qualifying Scorecard must be <u>signed and dated by the individual and attested by a playing partner</u>. All scorecards must be either turned into Lee in the Clubhouse or given to Tommy Daniel. Any rounds completed by <u>September 14</u>th will be eligible as qualifier rounds. Any individual may have as many qualifying rounds as they desire.
- The 7 remaining qualifying spots (and 2 alternates) available for the Senior County Cup will be determined by the lowest 3 average scores. Scores and best 3 averages will be posted on the bulletin board in the Club House.
