

# POOL NEWS

As summer fast approaches, we at Halifax Country Club are gearing up for lazy days by the pool. Please take a minute to review the following rules and policies and make it a great summer at the pool!

- ❖ The pool will open Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m with lifeguards on duty for the weekend.
- ❖ Lifeguards will be on duty 10:00 am – 5:00 pm daily after June 3rd.
- ❖ The pool closes for members at 11:00 pm each evening. The pool **WILL** be monitored by the Sherriff's Department. Anyone found at the pool after 11:00 pm will be charged with trespassing, member or not.
- ❖ Guest days for in-county guests will be on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays ONLY**. Guest fees are **\$5/guest**. Please do not make our lifeguards uncomfortable by bringing guests on other days. Continued disregard for this policy will result in suspension of pool privileges.
- ❖ Per the by-laws, out of county guests are welcome to swim **WITH A MEMBER** any day of the week for a maximum of 14 days during the season. There is **NO** guest fee for out of county guests.
- ❖ Please check in with a lifeguard upon arrival at the pool and pay guest fees if applicable.
- ❖ For children of members who will be accompanied to the pool by a non-member babysitter, a **\$100** Babysitter Pass must be purchased at the beginning of the summer. Babysitter passes may be purchased from Robbie Harris in the clubhouse.
- ❖ Children **9** and under must be accompanied by an adult. For those children **10-12**, a parent must let the lifeguard know at what point they will be coming unattended, and the child must pass a swim test.
- ❖ The pool is available for birthday parties. The cost will be **\$50**, which includes a lifeguard for two hours and up to 10 non-member guests. Persons reserving the pool **MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE** and at least **one adult must be present during the party**. Arrangements can be made through Brooke Gasperini at 575-1438, Martha Chandler at 575-0236, or with a lifeguard on duty. Fees are payable at time of party.
- ❖ When swimming during the day or in the evenings, please take the time to straighten up the pool area and throw your trash away before leaving. Extra trash bags can be found in the ladies bathroom supply cabinet if you should need them in the evenings.
- ❖ There will be scheduled "Adult Swims" during each day to give the adults a chance to enjoy the pool without children and give the lifeguards a chance to check on the bathrooms, skimmers, bathrooms, etc. All Adults **18 years and over** are invited to swim at their own risk during this time. All children **17 years of age and under** are invited to swim in the roped off shallow end under their parent's supervision.
